AGREEMENT FOR SURRENDER OF LICENSE

Respondent.

TO ALL PARTIES:

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the aboveentitled proceedings, that the following matters are true:

- 1. Complainant, William Prasifka, is the Executive Director of the Medical Board of California, Department of Consumer Affairs ("Board").
- 2. On or about January 29, 1968, the Medical Board of California issued Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate Number C 30935 to John William Annable, M.D. ("Respondent").
- 3. Respondent has carefully read and fully understands the effect of this Agreement. Respondent understands that by signing this Agreement, he is enabling the Board to issue this order accepting the surrender of license without further process. Respondent understands and agrees that Board staff and counsel for Complainant may communicate directly with the Board regarding this Agreement, without notice to or participation by Respondent. The Board will not be disqualified from further action in this matter by virtue of its consideration of this Agreement.
- 4. Respondent acknowledges there is current disciplinary action against his license, that on February 8, 2019, an Accusation was filed against him and on April 6, 2020, a Decision was rendered wherein his license was revoked, with the revocation stayed, and placed on probation for two years with various standard terms and conditions.

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- 5. Respondent further acknowledges on May 14, 2021, the Board issued a Cease Practice Order prohibiting Respondent from engaging in the practice of medicine. Respondent acknowledges that the Cease Practice Order will remain in place until the Board issues a final decision on an accusation and/or petition to revoke probation.
- 6. The current disciplinary action provides in pertinent part, "Following the effective date of this Decision, if Respondent ceases practicing due to retirement or health reasons or is otherwise unable to satisfy the terms and conditions of probation, Respondent may request to surrender his or her license. The Board reserves the right to evaluate Respondent's request and to exercise its discretion in determining whether or not to grant the request, or to take any other action deemed appropriate and reasonable under the circumstances. Upon formal acceptance of the surrender, Respondent shall within 15 calendar days deliver Respondent's wallet and wall certificate to the Board or its designee and Respondent shall no longer practice medicine. Respondent will no longer be subject to the terms and conditions of probation. If Respondent reapplies for a medical license, the application shall be treated as a petition for reinstatement of a revoked certificate." (Condition #14).
- 7. Upon acceptance of the Agreement by the Board, Respondent understands he will no longer be permitted to practice as a physician and surgeon in California, and also agrees to surrender his wallet certificate, wall license and any D.E.A. Certificate(s) for an address in California.
- 8. Respondent fully understands and agrees that if Respondent ever files an application for relicensure or reinstatement in the State of California, the Board shall treat it as a Petition for Reinstatement of a revoked license in effect at the time the Petition is filed. In addition, any Medical Board Investigation Report(s) and/or probation records, including all referenced documents and other exhibits in case numbers 800-2016-020208 and 800-2021-077872, and any such Investigation and/or Probation Report(s), attachments, and other exhibits, that may be generated subsequent to the filing of this Agreement for Surrender of License, shall be admissible as direct evidence, and any time-based defenses, such as laches or any applicable statute of limitations, shall be waived when the Board determines whether to grant or deny the Petition.

ACCEPTANCE

I, John William Annable, M.D., have carefully read the above Agreement and have fully discussed it with my attorney, Gregory R. Bunch, and with full knowledge of its force and effect, do hereby surrender Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate No. C 30935, to the Medical Board of California for its acceptance. By signing this Agreement for Surrender of License, I recognize that upon its formal acceptance by the Board, I will lose all rights and privileges to practice as a Physician and Surgeon in the State of California and that I have delivered to the Board my wallet certificate and wall license.
