**STIPULATED SURRENDER OF
LICENSE AND ORDER**

Respondent.

17 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-
18 entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:

19 **PARTIES**

20 1. William Prasifka (Complainant) was the Executive Director of the Medical Board of
21 California (Board). He brought this action solely in his official capacity, and he and Deputy
22 Director Reji Varghese, also acting in his official capacity, are represented in this matter by Rob
23 Bonta, Attorney General of the State of California, by Mary Cain-Simon, Supervising Deputy
24 Attorney General.

25 2. Laurence Howard Lief, M.D. (Respondent) is representing himself in this proceeding
26 by and through his court-appointed conservator and has chosen not to exercise his right to be
27 represented by counsel.

1 1. The surrender of Respondent's Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate and the
2 acceptance of the surrendered license by the Board shall constitute the imposition of discipline
3 against Respondent. This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall become a part
4 of Respondent's license history with the Board.

5 2. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as a Physician and Surgeon in
6 California as of the effective date of the Board's Decision and Order.

7 3. Respondent shall cause to be delivered to the Board his pocket license and, if one was
8 issued, his wall certificate on or before the effective date of the Decision and Order.

9 4. If Respondent ever files an application for licensure or a petition for reinstatement in
10 the State of California, the Board shall treat it as a petition for reinstatement. Respondent must
11 comply with all the laws, regulations and procedures for reinstatement of a revoked or
12 surrendered license in effect at the time the petition is filed, and all of the charges and allegations
13 contained in Accusation No. 800-2022-091272 shall be deemed to be true, correct and admitted
14 by Respondent when the Board determines whether to grant or deny the petition.

15 5. If Respondent should ever apply or reapply for a new license or certification, or
16 petition for reinstatement of a license, by any other health care licensing agency in the State of
17 California, all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation, No. 800-2022-091272 shall
18 be deemed to be true, correct, and admitted by Respondent for the purpose of any Statement of
19 Issues or any other proceeding seeking to deny or restrict licensure.

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ACCEPTANCE

I have carefully read the Stipulated Surrender of License and Order. I understand the stipulation and the effect it will have on Respondent's Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate. I enter into this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree that Respondent will be bound by the Decision and Order of the Medical Board of California.

18 **PARTIES**

19 1. William Prasifka (Complainant) brings this Accusation solely in his official capacity
20 as the Executive Director of the Medical Board of California, Department of Consumer Affairs
21 (Board).

22 2. On or about July 31, 1978, the Medical Board issued Physician's and Surgeon's
23 Certificate Number G 37686 to Laurence Howard Lief, M.D. (Respondent). The Physician's and
24 Surgeon's Certificate was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought
25 herein and will expire on November 30, 2023, unless renewed.

1 JURISDICTION

2 3. This Accusation is brought before the Board, under the authority of the following
3 laws. All section references are to the Business and Professions Code (Code) unless otherwise
4 indicated.

5 4. Section 822 of the Code states:

6 If a licensing agency determines that its licentiate's ability to practice his or her
7 profession safely is impaired because the licentiate is mentally ill, or physically ill
8 affecting competency, the licensing agency may take action by any one of the
9 following methods:

10 (a) Revoking the licentiate's certificate or license.

11 (b) Suspending the licentiate's right to practice.

12 (c) Placing the licentiate on probation.

13 (d) Taking such other action in relation to the licentiate as the licensing agency
14 in its discretion deems proper.

15 The licensing section shall not reinstate a revoked or suspended certificate or
16 license until it has received competent evidence of the absence or control of the
17 condition which caused its action and until it is satisfied that with due regard for the
18 public health and safety the person's right to practice his or her profession may be
19 safely reinstated.

20 5. Section 2004 of the Code states:

21 The board shall have the responsibility for the following:

22 (a) The enforcement of the disciplinary and criminal provisions of the Medical
23 Practice Act.

24 (b) The administration and hearing of disciplinary actions.

25 (c) Carrying out disciplinary actions appropriate to findings made by a panel or
26 an administrative law judge.

27 (d) Suspending, revoking, or otherwise limiting certificates after the conclusion
28 of disciplinary actions.

(e) Reviewing the quality of medical practice carried out by physician and
surgeon certificate holders under the jurisdiction of the board.

(f) Approving undergraduate and graduate medical education programs.

(g) Approving clinical clerkship and special programs and hospitals for the
programs in subdivision (f).

1 (h) Issuing licenses and certificates under the board's jurisdiction.

2 (i) Administering the board's continuing medical education program.

3 **CAUSE FOR BOARD ACTION**

4 **(Physical or Mental Impairment)**

5 6. Respondent Laurence Howard Lief, M.D. is subject to action under section 822 in
6 that good cause exists to believe that Respondent's ability to practice medicine safely is impaired
7 by physical and/or mental illness. The circumstances are as follows:

8 7. On August 24, 2022, the Board received a letter from the Chief of Staff for California
9 Pacific Medical Center, reporting concerns regarding Dr. Lief's health and fitness to practice
10 medicine. The letter also contained information to the effect that a number of medical staff
11 leaders had expressed concerns that Dr. Lief was suffering from memory issues.

12 9. Board investigators contacted Dr. Lief, and received information from Dr. Lief's family
13 members affirming that Dr. Lief is having severe memory problems.

14 10. On Friday, December 2, 2022, the Board received a copy of a sworn Capacity
15 Declaration authored by Armen Moughamian, M.D., PhD. In that declaration, Dr. Moughamian
16 avers that Dr. Lief is suffering major impairments of his mental functioning, including
17 impairment as to awareness of time, such as what day or month it is, short-term memory and
18 immediate recall, and abilities to plan and reason. Dr. Moughamian additionally describes his
19 review of an MRI of Dr. Lief's brain taken July 2022, and compared it with a prior scan from
20 October 2011. Among other findings, Dr. Moughamian concludes that Dr. Lief is suffering from
21 a clinical condition that impairs his ability to safely practice medicine.

22 **PRAYER**

23 WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged,
24 and that following the hearing, the Medical Board of California issue a decision:

25 1. Revoking or suspending Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate Number G 37686,
26 issued to Laurence Howard Lief, M.D.;


27 2. Revoking, suspending or denying approval of Laurence Howard Lief, M.D.'s
28 authority to supervise physician assistants and advanced practice nurses;

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3. Ordering Laurence Howard Lief, M.D., to pay the Board the costs of the investigation and enforcement of this case, and if placed on probation, the costs of probation monitoring; and

5. Taking such other and further action as deemed necessary and proper.
