**AGREEMENT FOR SURRENDER OF

20 **TO ALL PARTIES:**

21 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-  
22 entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:

23 1. Reji Verghese (Complainant) is the Interim Executive Director of the Medical Board  
24 of California (Board). He brought this action solely in his official capacity and is represented in  
25 this matter by Rob Bonta, Attorney General of the State of California, by Christine A. Rhee,  
26 Deputy Attorney General.

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1           2.     Mohamed Waddah El-Nachef, M.D. (Respondent) has carefully read and fully  
2 understands the effect of this Agreement.

3           3.     Respondent understands that by signing this Agreement he is enabling the Board to  
4 issue this order accepting the surrender of license without further process. Respondent  
5 understands and agrees that Board staff and counsel for Complainant may communicate directly  
6 with the Board regarding this Agreement, without notice to or participation by Respondent. The  
7 Board will not be disqualified from further action in this matter by virtue of its consideration of  
8 this Agreement.

9           4.     Respondent acknowledges that there is a current disciplinary action against his  
10 license, that on May 16, 2019, an Accusation was filed against him and on February 5, 2020, a  
11 Decision was rendered wherein his license was revoked, with revocation stayed, and placed on  
12 seven (7) years of probation with various terms and conditions.

13          5.     Respondent further acknowledges that in Orange County Superior Court Case No.  
14 20NF0688, on or about September 28, 2022, Respondent pled guilty to one felony count of  
15 insurance fraud, in violation of Penal Code section 550, subdivision (b)(3), and to one felony  
16 count of aiding and abetting the unlicensed practice of medicine, in violation of Business and  
17 Professions Code section 2052, subdivision (b).

18          6.     Respondent further acknowledges that in Orange County Superior Court Case No.  
19 20NF0688, Respondent signed a written plea agreement in which he admitted the following: (1)  
20 he knowingly and willfully conspired with and aided and abetted Steven Fleming, Oscar Abrons  
21 III, Marcella Charles, Youpa Valentine, and others by participating in a scheme to defraud the  
22 Medi-Cal Program; and (2) he prescribed medically unnecessary antiviral medications,  
23 antipsychotics, and opioids to hundreds of patients at Cancer Treatment Center in Orange County  
24 and God's Property in Los Angeles County which were billed to Medi-Cal and paid for by the  
25 Medi-Cal Program. Respondent further admitted that he was aware that Steven Fleming and  
26 Oscar Abrons III were not licensed healthcare providers, yet he still agreed to work with them at  
27 God's Property, their unlicensed medical clinic. Respondent also admitted that the loss caused to  
28 Medi-Cal as a result of the scheme exceeded \$20 million.

7. The current disciplinary action provides, in pertinent part, that “[f]ollowing the effective date of this Decision, if Respondent ceases practicing due to retirement, health reasons, or is otherwise unable to satisfy the terms and conditions of probation, Respondent may request voluntary surrender of Respondent’s license.” (Condition No. 18).

8. Upon acceptance of the Agreement by the Board, Respondent understands he will no longer be permitted to practice as a physician and surgeon in California, and also agrees to surrender his wallet certificate, wall license, and any D.E.A. Certificate(s) for an address in California.

9. Respondent fully understands and agrees that if Respondent ever files an application for re-licensure or reinstatement in the State of California, the Board shall treat it as a Petition for Reinstatement of a revoked license in effect at the time the Petition is filed. In addition, any Medical Board Investigation Report(s), including all referenced documents and other exhibits, upon which the Board is predicated, and any such Investigation Report(s), attachments, and other exhibits that may be generated subsequent to the filing of this Agreement for Surrender of License, shall be admissible as direct evidence, and any time-based defenses, such as laches or any applicable statute of limitations, shall be waived when the Board determines whether to grant or deny the Petition.

## ACCEPTANCE

I, Mohamed Waddah El-Nachef, M.D., have carefully read the above Agreement and enter into it freely and voluntarily, with the optional advice of counsel, and with full knowledge of its force and effect, do hereby surrender Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate No. C 50556 to the Medical Board of California for its acceptance. By signing this Agreement for Surrender of License, I recognize that upon its formal acceptance by the Board, I will lose all rights and privileges to practice as a Physician and Surgeon in the State of California and that I have delivered to the Board my wallet certificate and wall license.
