PRACTICE; ORDER**

Defendant Randy Scott Rosen, M.D. (Defendant) and William Prasifka, Executive Director of the Medical Board of California (Applicant), hereby stipulate to the following:

1. Defendant is represented in the above-entitled matter by Harland W. Braun, Esq., whose office is located at: 10250 Constellation Blvd., Ste. 1020, Los Angeles, CA 90067, phone

1 number (310) 277-4777, and Jerry R. Sparks, Esq, whose office is located at: 650 Town Center
2 Drive, Ste. 1200, Costa Mesa, CA 92626, phone number (714) 546-4300.

3 2. Applicant, William Prasifka, Executive Director of the Medical Board of California,
4 is represented in the above-entitled matter by Xavier Becerra, Attorney General of the State of
5 California, by Deputy Attorney General LeAnna E. Shields.

6 3. The Medical Board of California is a state agency charged with protecting the public
7 through the licensing and discipline of physicians in the State of California.

8 4. On March 20, 1996, the Medical Board of California issued Physician's and
9 Surgeon's Certificate No. G 82218 to Defendant. Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate No. G
10 82218 is current and will expire on June 30, 2021, unless renewed.

11 5. On or about June 25, 2020, a Felony Complaint was filed in *People of the State of*
12 *California v. Randy Scott Rosen*, Superior Court of California, County of Orange, Case No.
13 20CF1682, charging Defendant with thirty-two (32) felony counts of conspiring to violate and/or
14 violating Penal Code sections 550 and 549, and twenty-three (23) counts of violating Penal Code
15 section 186.10, subdivision (a), money laundering. The Felony Complaint also alleges other
16 allegations pursuant to Penal Code section 186.11, subdivision (a), causing losses over \$500,000,
17 Penal Code section 186.10, subdivision (c)(1)(A), causing losses over \$150,000, Penal Code
18 section 186.10, subdivision (c)(1)(B), causing losses over \$50,000, Penal Code section
19 186.10(c)(1)(C), causing losses over \$1,000,000, and Penal Code section 12022.1, subdivision
20 (b), commission while released on bail.

21 6. Penal Code section 23 authorizes a state agency to voluntarily appear in a criminal
22 proceeding and make a recommendation to the Court to promote the interests of justice and
23 protect the interests of the public if the crime charged is substantially related to the qualifications,
24 functions, or duties of the licensee.

25 7. The Medical Board of California filed and served a Notice of Appearance and
26 Recommendation by State Licensing Agency [pursuant to Penal Code section 23] on or about
27 July 13, 2020, seeking to prohibit Defendant from practicing medicine as a condition of bail
28 and/or any possible own recognizance release in Superior Court Case No. 20CF1682.


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8. The parties, through their respective attorneys, have reached an agreement, and Defendant stipulates and agrees as follows:

Defendant shall be, and immediately is, prohibited from practicing, or attempting to practice medicine, until the above-captioned criminal proceeding is fully and completely concluded.




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ORDER
