17 1. On September 28, 2020, an employee of the Medical Board of California (Board)  
18 sent by certified mail a copy of Accusation No. 800-2020-066218, Statement to Respondent,  
19 Notice of Defense in blank, copies of the relevant sections of the California Administrative  
20 Procedure Act as required by sections 11503 and 11505 of the Government Code, and a request  
21 for discovery, to Larry Homer Smith, M.D. (Respondent) at his address of record with the Board,  
22 which was and is, 6422 Memphis Street, New Orleans, LA 70124-3151. (Accusation package,  
23 proof of service, Exhibit Package, Exhibit 1<sup>1</sup>.)

24 2. There was no response to the Accusation. On November 4, 2020, an employee of the  
25 Attorney General's Office sent a Courtesy Notice of Default, by certified mail, addressed to  
26 Respondent at the address of record above. The Courtesy Notice of Default advised Respondent

1 of the service Accusation, and provided him with an opportunity to file a Notice of Defense and  
2 request relief from default. The United States Post Office tracking system shows that the package  
3 was delivered to the address on November 7, 2020. (Exhibit Package, Exhibit 2, Courtesy Notice  
4 of Default, proof of service, USPS tracking.)

5 3. Respondent has not responded to service of the Accusation or the Notice of Default.  
6 He has not filed a Notice of Defense. As a result, Respondent has waived his right to a hearing  
7 on the merits to contest the allegations contained in the Accusation.

### 8 FINDINGS OF FACT

9 4. William Prasifka is the Board's Executive Director. The charges and allegations in  
10 the Accusation were at all times brought and maintained solely in the official capacity of the  
11 Board's Executive Director.

12 5. On August 26, 1975, Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate No. C36737 was issued  
13 by the Board to Larry Homer Smith, M.D. The certificate is delinquent, having expired on July  
14 31, 2020, and is suspended by virtue of an Order issued on August 12, 2020, pursuant to Business  
15 and Professions Code section 2310(a). (Exhibit Package, Exhibit 3, license certification.)

16 6. On September 28, 2020, Respondent was duly served with an Accusation, alleging  
17 causes for discipline against Respondent. A Courtesy Notice of Default was thereafter served on  
18 Respondent. Respondent failed to file a Notice of Defense.

19 7. The allegations of the Accusation are true as follows:

20 On February 17, 2020, the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners issued an Interim  
21 Consent Order regarding Respondent's license to practice medicine in the State of Louisiana.  
22 Under the terms of the Interim Consent Order, Respondent's Louisiana license is indefinitely  
23 suspended.<sup>2</sup> The Interim Consent Order was issued based on information that Respondent suffers  
24 from a medical condition that affects his ability to safely practice medicine. Respondent's  
25 Louisiana license will only be reinstated following a re-evaluation and a satisfactory report  
26 concerning Respondent's medical condition, a meeting with Louisiana board personnel and the

1 conclusion of the pending investigation and a final decision by the Louisiana board on any  
2 charges that may be filed. A copy of the Interim Consent Order issued by the Louisiana State  
3 Board of Medical Examiners is attached as Exhibit A to the Accusation, Exhibit Package.  
4 Exhibit 1.

#### 5 DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

6 8. The Board has jurisdiction to adjudicate this case by default, and pursuant to  
7 Government Code section 11520, finds that Respondent is in default. The Board will take action  
8 without further proceedings or hearing and, based on Respondent's admissions by way of default  
9 and the evidence before the Board, contained in the Exhibit Package, finds that the allegations in  
10 the Accusation are true and correct.

11 9. Respondent's conduct and the action of the Louisiana State Board of Medical  
12 Examiners constitute cause for discipline within the meaning of Business and Professions Code  
13 sections 2305 and 141(a).


#### 14 DISCIPLINARY ORDER

15 Physician's and Surgeon's certificate No. C36737 issued to Larry Homer Smith, M.D.  
16 is hereby **REVOKED**.

17 Respondent shall not be deprived of making a request for relief from default as set forth in  
18 Government Code section 11520(c) for good cause shown. However, such showing must be  
19 made in writing by way of a motion to vacate the default decision and directed to the Medical  
20 Board of California at 2005 Evergreen Street, Suite 1200, Sacramento, CA 95815 within seven  
21 (7) days of the service of this Decision.

22 This Decision shall become effective at 5:00 p.m. on **DEC 31 2020**

19 **PARTIES**

20 1. William Prasifka (Complainant) brings this Accusation solely in his official capacity  
21 as the Executive Director of the Medical Board of California, Department of Consumer Affairs  
22 (Board).

23 2. On August 26, 1975, the Medical Board issued Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate  
24 Number C 36737 to Larry Homer Smith, M.D. (Respondent). The Physician's and Surgeon's  
25 Certificate expired on July 31, 2020, and has not been renewed. The certificate is suspended by  
26 virtue of an Order issued on August 12, 2020 pursuant to Business and Professions Code section  
27 2310(a).

1 **JURISDICTION**

2 3. This Accusation is brought before the Medical Board of California under the  
3 authority of the following sections of the California Business and Professions Code (Code) and/or  
4 other relevant statutory enactment:

5 A. Section 2227 of the Code provides in part that the Board may revoke, suspend for a  
6 period not to exceed one year, or place on probation, the license of any licensee who has  
7 been found guilty under the Medical Practice Act, and may recover the costs of probation  
8 monitoring.

9 B. Section 2305 of the Code provides, in part, that the revocation, suspension, or other  
10 discipline, restriction or limitation imposed by another state upon a license to practice  
11 medicine issued by that state, or the revocation, suspension, or restriction of the authority  
12 to practice medicine by any agency of the federal government, that would have been  
13 grounds for discipline in California under the Medical Practice Act, constitutes grounds for  
14 discipline for unprofessional conduct.

15 C. Section 141 of the Code provides:

16 “(a) For any licensee holding a license issued by a board under the  
17 jurisdiction of a department, a disciplinary action taken by another state, by any  
18 agency of the federal government, or by another country for any act  
19 substantially related to the practice regulated by the California license, may be  
20 a ground for disciplinary action by the respective state licensing board. A  
21 certified copy of the record of the disciplinary action taken against the licensee  
22 by another state, an agency of the federal government, or by another country  
23 shall be conclusive evidence of the events related therein.”

24 “(b) Nothing in this section shall preclude a board from applying a  
25 specific statutory provision in the licensing act administered by the board that  
26 provides for discipline based upon a disciplinary action taken against the  
27 licensee by another state, an agency of the federal government, or another  
28 country.”

**FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE**

**(Discipline, Restriction, or Limitation Imposed by Another State)**

4. On February 17, 2020, the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners issued an  
Interim Consent Order regarding Respondent’s license to practice medicine in the State of  
Louisiana. The Interim Consent Order was issued based on information that Respondent suffers

1 from a medical condition that affects his ability to safely practice medicine. Respondent's  
2 Louisiana license will only be reinstated following a re-evaluation and a satisfactory report  
3 concerning Respondent's medical condition, a meeting with Louisiana board personnel and the  
4 conclusion of the pending investigation and a final decision by the Louisiana board on any  
5 charges that may be filed. A copy of the Interim Consent Order issued by the Louisiana State  
6 Board of Medical Examiners is attached as Exhibit A.


7 5. Respondent's medical condition and the action of the Louisiana State Board of  
8 Medical Examiners, set forth above, constitute cause for discipline pursuant to sections 2305  
9 and/or 141 of the Code.

10 **PRAYER**

11 WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged,  
12 and that following the hearing, the Medical Board of California issue a decision:

- 13 1. Revoking or suspending Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate Number C 36737,  
14 issued to Larry Homer Smith, M.D.;
- 15 2. Revoking, suspending or denying approval of Larry Homer Smith, M.D.'s authority to  
16 supervise physician assistants and advanced practice nurses;
- 17 3. Ordering Larry Homer Smith, M.D., if placed on probation, to pay the Board the  
18 costs of probation monitoring; and
- 19 4. Taking such other and further action as deemed necessary and proper.

INTERIM  
CONSENT ORDER

---

This matter is before the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Board") in connection with an ongoing and pending investigation conducted by the Investigating Officer of the Board regarding Laurence H. Smith, M.D. ("Dr. Smith"), a physician who at all pertinent times has been licensed and engaged in the practice of cardiothoracic surgery in and around New Orleans, Louisiana.

The Board received apparently reliable information that indicates that Dr. Smith suffers from a medical condition, which affects his ability to practice with skill and safety.

Predicated upon the information outlined above, the Investigating Officer assigned by the Board with respect to this matter has determined that reasonable cause exists for recommending that a formal Administrative Complaint be filed against Dr. Smith, charging him with violation of the Louisiana Medical Practice Act (the "Act"), pursuant to La. Rev. Stat. §§ 37:1285(A) (25).<sup>1</sup>

As evidenced by his subscription hereto, Dr. Smith acknowledges the right to have written notification of any charges that may be asserted, as well as the right to have evidence of such charges asserted during an administrative hearing at which time he will be entitled to be represented by legal counsel, to call witnesses and to present evidence in defense or in mitigation of the charges made, and to a decision thereon by the Board based upon written findings of fact and conclusions of law, pursuant to La. Rev. Stat. §§49:951, *et seq.* Irrespective of such rights, Dr. Smith, nonetheless, hereby consents to the indefinite suspension of his license to practice medicine in this state, with reinstatement thereof subject to the terms and conditions of this Order. By his subscription hereto, Dr. Smith authorizes the Investigating Officer designated by

Stat. §37:1285(A) provides that the Board may take action against the licensee or applicant who has been found guilty of conduct which has endangered or is likely to endanger the health, welfare, or safety of the public, to include: (25) 'Inability to practice medicine with reasonable competence, skill, or safety to patients because of mental or physical illness or deficiency, including but not limited to deterioration through the aging process or excessive use or abuse of drugs, including alcohol.'

the Board with respect hereto to present this Interim Consent Order to the Board for its consideration and to fully discuss with and disclose to the Board the nature and extent of such charges and he waives any objection to such disclosures under La. Rev. Stat. §49:960. Dr. Smith expressly acknowledges that disclosure of such information to the Board by the Investigating Officer shall be without prejudice to the Investigating Officer's authority to prosecute administrative charges which may be filed in this matter following completion of the current investigation or to the Board's capacity to adjudicate such charges.

Accordingly, in consideration of the foregoing and pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by La. Rev. Stat. §37:1285 and La. Rev. Stat. §49:955(D);

**IT IS ORDERED** that the license of Laurence H. Smith, M.D. to engage in the practice of medicine in the State of Louisiana, as evidenced by Certificate No.09567, be and the same is hereby, effective as of the date hereof, **INDEFINITELY SUSPENDED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Laurence H. Smith, M.D. shall not practice medicine in any form in the State of Louisiana until and unless the Board issues and serves a written decision reinstating his license to practice following: (1) a re-evaluation and a satisfactory report concerning his medical condition; (2) a meeting at the Board office with the Director of Investigations or designee; and (3) the conclusion of the pending investigation by administrative hearing and final decision of the Board on any charges that may be filed in these proceedings including, but not limited to, those identified in this Order; or alternatively, by the Board's acceptance of a Consent Order or other disposition of the pending investigation.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that any violation or failure of strict compliance with any of the terms, conditions or restrictions set forth by this Order by Dr. Smith shall be deemed adequate and sufficient cause, upon proof of such violation or failure, for the revocation and cancellation of Dr. Smith's license to practice medicine in the State of Louisiana or for such other action as the Board may deem appropriate, as if such violations were enumerated among the causes provided in La. Rev. Stat. § 37:1285.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this Interim Consent Order shall be, and shall be deemed to be, a public record.
