REVOCATION OF LICENSE**

23 TO: RESPONDENT JAY LIN, M.D.:

24 **YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED** that the Medical Board of California, Department of
25 Consumer Affairs (Board), has automatically revoked Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate No.
26 A 116175 by operation of law after having received and reviewed a copy of the record of
27 criminal conviction described below:

1 1. On November 29, 2021, Respondent entered a plea of guilty in the case of *The State*
2 *of Texas v. Jay Lin*, State of Texas, Montgomery County, District Court Case No. 19-08-10484.

3 2. The court record establishes that Respondent was convicted of 1 count of violating
4 Texas Penal Code section 33.021(c) [Online Solicitation of a Minor]. The criminal convictions
5 require Respondent to register as a sex offender. (Cal. Pen. Code, §§ 290.005, 290.)

11 **SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION: AUTOMATIC REVOCATION**

12 4. Section 2232 of the California Business and Professions Code states in pertinent part:

13 “(a) Except as provided in subdivisions (c), (d), and (e), the board shall automatically
14 revoke the license of any person who, at any time after January 1, 1947, has been required to
15 register as a sex offender pursuant to the provisions of Section 290 of the Penal Code, regardless
16 of whether the related conviction has been appealed. The board shall notify the licensee of the
17 license revocation and of his or her right to elect to have a hearing as provided in subdivision (b).

18 “(b) Upon revocation of the physician’s and surgeon’s certificate, the holder of the
19 certificate may request a hearing within 30 days of the revocation. The proceeding shall be
20 conducted in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act (Chapter 5 (commencing with
21 Section 11500) of Part I of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code).”

22 **WHEREFORE, THE MEDICAL BOARD OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT OF**

**ADMONITIONS TO THE DEFENDANT
FOR PLEA TO COURT**

1. The range of punishment attached to the offense to which Defendant is pleading, including enhancements, if any, is:

- (Capital Felony - death penalty waived) confinement in the Institutional Division for life.
- (Habitual Offender) confinement in the Institutional Division for life or a term of not more than 99 years or less than 25 years.
- (First Degree Felony + Repeat Offenders) confinement in the Institutional Division for life or a term of not more than 99 years or less than 15 years; in addition, a fine not to exceed \$10,000 may be imposed.
- (First Degree Felony) confinement in the Institutional Division for life or a term of not more than 99 years or less than 5 years; in addition, a fine not to exceed \$10,000 may be imposed.
- (Second Degree Felony) confinement in the Institutional Division for a term of not more than 20 years or less than 2 years; in addition, a fine not to exceed \$10,000 may be imposed.
- (Third Degree Felony) confinement in the Institutional Division for a term of not more than 10 years or less than 2 years; in addition, a fine not to exceed \$10,000 may be imposed.
- (State Jail Felony) confinement in state jail for not more than 2 years or less than 180 days; in addition, a fine not to exceed \$10,000 may be imposed. Under § 12.44(a), PC, confinement in county jail for not more than one year and/or a maximum fine of \$4,000. If the offense is possession of a controlled substance (Penalty Group 1 or 2), LSD (5 abuse units or less), or marihuana (1 lb. Or less) or fraud (by prescription for schedule II or III drugs), and the Defendant has no prior felony conviction, judge shall suspend sentence and place the Defendant on probation.
- (Class A Misdemeanor or Punishment assessed under 12.44 (b) of the Penal Code) confinement in county jail for not more than one year and/or a maximum fine of \$4,000. For a second DWI committed after 8/31/95, the minimum confinement in jail is 30 days.
- (Class B Misdemeanor) confinement in county jail for not more than 180 days and/or a maximum fine of \$ 2,000.00. For a first DWI committed after 8/31/94, the minimum confinement in county jail is 72 hours.
- (Special punishment range) _____.

2. The recommendation of the District Attorney is not binding on the court. The court will inquire as to the existence of a plea agreement and, if any exists, inform Defendant in open court before any finding on the plea whether the court will follow such agreement. Should the court reject a plea agreement, Defendant shall be permitted to withdraw the plea of guilty or no contest.

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3. If the punishment assessed does not exceed the punishment recommended by the District Attorney and agreed to by Defendant and his attorney, Defendant must request and receive the trial court's permission before he or she may pursue an appeal on any matter in his or her case, except for those matters raised by written motions filed prior to trial.

4. I am not (circle one) a citizen or legal resident of the United States of America. If not a US citizen, I am a citizen of China and hereby waive all potential rights afforded me by treaty. If I am not a citizen of the United States of America, a plea of guilty or no contest for the offense charged may result in deportation, the exclusion from admission to this country, or the denial of naturalization under federal law.

5. If I am convicted of or placed on deferred adjudication for an offense triggering the Sex Offender Registration Program, Defendant will be required to meet the registration requirements of that law. For a list of offenses triggering sex offender registration and the details of that law, see Chapter 62, CCP. Defendant understands that the sex offender registration laws include many details other than those listed in these admonitions, are subject to change, and may be applied retroactively. Failure to comply with the registration law is a felony criminal offense.

6. If I am placed on deferred adjudication, upon violation of a condition of community supervision, the Defendant may be arrested and detained. The Defendant is entitled to a hearing limited to the determination by the judge whether it proceeds with an adjudication of guilt on the original charge. After an adjudication of guilt, all proceedings, including assessment of punishment, pronouncement of sentence, granting of community supervision, and defendant's appeal continue as if the adjudication of guilt had not been deferred.

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
