19	IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGR	EED by and between the parties to the above-	
20	entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:		
21	<u>PARTIES</u>		
22	1. William Prasifka ("Complainant") is the Executive Director of the Medical Board of		
23	California (Board). He brought this action solely in his official capacity and is represented in thi		
24	matter by Xavier Becerra, Attorney General of the State of California, by Rebecca L. Smith,		
25	Deputy Attorney General.		
26	2. Herbert Sim-On Chin, M.D. ("Respondent") is representing himself in this		
27	proceeding and has chosen not to exercise his right to be represented by counsel.		
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3. On or about May 22, 1998, the Board issued Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate No. A 65244 to Respondent. That license was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 800-2019-056409 and will expire on May 31, 2022, unless renewed.

### **JURISDICTION**

4. Accusation No. 800-2019-056409 was filed before the Board, and is currently pending against Respondent. The Accusation and all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondent. A copy of Accusation No. 800-2019-056409 is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference.

# ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

- 5. Respondent has carefully read, and understands the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 800-2019-056409. Respondent also has carefully read, and understands the effects of this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order.
- 6. Respondent is fully aware of his legal rights in this matter, including the right to a hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to be represented by counsel, at his own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against him; the right to present evidence and to testify on his own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.
- 7. Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and every right set forth above.

## **CULPABILITY**

8. Respondent admits the truth of each and every charge and allegation in Accusation No. 800-2019-056409, agrees that cause exists for discipline and hereby surrenders his Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate No A 65244 for the Board's formal acceptance.

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9. Respondent understands that by signing this stipulation he enables the Board to issue an order accepting the surrender of his Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate without further process.

# **CONTINGENCY**

- 10. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Board. Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Board may communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and surrender, without notice to or participation by Respondent. By signing the stipulation, Respondent understands and agrees that he may not withdraw his agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Surrender and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.
- 11. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format ("PDF") and facsimile copies of this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order, including PDF and facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.
- 12. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following Order:

#### **ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate No. A 65244, issued to Respondent Herbert Sim-On Chin, M.D., is surrendered and accepted by the Board.

- 1. The surrender of Respondent's Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate and the acceptance of the surrendered license by the Board shall constitute the imposition of discipline against Respondent. This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall become a part of Respondent's license history with the Board.
- 2. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as a psychiatrist in California as of the effective date of the Board's Decision and Order.

21	1. William Prasifka (Complainant) brings this Accusation solely in his official capacity				
22	as the Executive Director of the Medical Board of California, Department of Consumer Affairs				
23	(Board).				
24	2. On or about May 22, 1998, the Medical Board issued Physician's and Surgeon's				
25	Certificate Number A 65244 to Herbert Sim-On Chin, M.D. (Respondent). The Physician's and				
26	Surgeon's Certificate was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought				
27	herein and will expire on May 31, 2022, unless renewed.				
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- 3. On January 22, 2021, an Order on Petition for Interim Suspension Order was issued pursuant to stipulation by Respondent. Pursuant to that Order, Respondent's Physician's & Surgeon's Certificate No. A 65244 is suspended and Respondent is restrained and prohibited from practicing or attempting to practice as a physician and surgeon in California pending a final Decision by the Board. Respondent is immediately restrained and prohibited from the following:
  - a. Practicing or attempting to practice as a physician and surgeon in California;
- b. Advertising, by any means, or holding himself out as practicing or available to practice medicine or to supervise physician assistants or advanced practice nurses;
- c. Possessing, ordering, purchasing, receiving, prescribing, dispensing, furnishing, administering or otherwise distributing any controlled substance or any dangerous drug in California, as defined by federal or state law, except legally permitted drugs prescribed to Respondent by his treating physician and surgeon;
- d. Possessing or holding his California physician's and surgeon's wall and wallet certificates, and possessing any and all prescription blanks.
- e. Respondent was further ordered to immediately deliver to the Board, or its agent, for safekeeping pending a final administrative order of the Board in this matter, all indicia of his licensure as a physician, as contemplated by Business and Professions Code Section 119, including but not limited to his wall certificate and wallet card issued by the Board, as well as all prescription forms, all prescription drugs not legally prescribed to Respondent by his treating physician and surgeon, all Drug Enforcement Administration Drug Order forms, and all Drug Enforcement Administration permits.

#### **JURISDICTION**

- 4. This Accusation is brought before the Board under the authority of the following provisions of the Business and Professions Code ("Code") unless otherwise indicated.
  - 5. Section 2004 of the Code states:
    - The board shall have the responsibility for the following:
    - (a) The enforcement of the disciplinary and criminal provisions of the Medical

23	costs of probation monitoring;
